



## Gêm i ddysgu am odrifau ac eilrifau

- ◊ Gêm i 2 neu i ddau dîm
- ◊ Byddwch angen dîs a chopi o'r bwrdd chwarae uchod.
- ◊ Rhowch "drysor" ar y gist (ceiniogau, botymau, lego etc)
- ◊ Mae hi'n bosib prynu dis efo mwy na 6 wyneb.
- ◊ Os nad oes gennych ddîs, gwnewch bentwr o gardiau bach gyda rhifau arnynt. (Mae'r cardiau yn syniad da os ydych eisiau cynnwys rhifau uwch na 6)
- ◊ Taflwch y dis / pigwch cerdyn o'r pentwr yn eich tro.
- ◊ Os ydych yn taflu/ pigo odrif cymerwch 2 ddarn o drysor;
- ◊ Os rydych yn taflu eilrif rydych yn cael 1 darn o drysor.
  
- ◊ Mae pawb yn cael taflu dîs 6 gwaith cyn cyfri i weld pwy sydd efo mwya' o drysor

## A game to learn odd and even numbers

- ◊ a game for 2 players / teams
- ◊ You will need a dice and a copy of the gameboard
- ◊ Put "treasure" in the chest (buttons, pennies, lego etc)
- ◊ It is possible to buy dice with more than 6 faces
- ◊ If you don't have a dice, make a pile of small numbered cards—this is a good idea if you want to include larger numbers)
- ◊ Take turns to throw dice / pick up card from pile.
- ◊ If you throw/pick and odd number, take 2 pieces of treasure
- ◊ If you throw / pick and even number, take 1 piece
  
- ◊ Everyone has 6 turns before adding the treasure to see who has the most
