

Ideas to support learning and language development

Name objects and make sure the child knows what they are and uses the words

Role play being an atronaut/alien

Have fun

Make a map of space – what will we be flying past, what will we see ?

Cut out pictures of the planets, name them and put them in order. Talk about what might be on that planet

Tell a space story

## Give clear instructions

Take photos to create memories

Use positional language

Make a space ship from cardboard boxes or on the trampoline

Make a rocket from a plastic bottle

Make a space suit from a one –sie and wellies

Ask lots of questions

Make planets out of a ball or cut out circles and colour them all differently-talk about patterns/sizes/shapes

Model how to be a spaceman

Make a flag to put

Explain what things are

Make a helmet from a box and foil – cut out a slit for the eyes

Show pictures to help the child understand

Make a control panel from old lids and tops

Find a place to be the moon – a sheet made into a circle or on the trampoline
